

NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES RE: FRAUDULENT REPORTING OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAMS

All employees are hereby notified that reporting of fraudulent workers' compensation claims is a crime. As indicated in ARS §23-1028, any person convicted of fraudulently seeking workers' compensation or other benefits will:

- forfeit all right to such compensation, benefit, or payment after conviction of the offense;
- be found guilty of a class 6 felony;
- be sentenced to pay an amount fixed by the court of not more than \$50,000; and
- be required to return any monies, interest, or real or personal property that was acquired (an order of restitution may also include expenses incurred and paid by an insurer in connection with any medical evaluation or treatment services).
